Where? Edmonton Int'l Raceway

Located in Wetaskiwin

4 kms West of the Hwy 2A and Hwy 13 Junction in Wetaskiwin

Do I need tickets? Yes, tickets are available now online at www.edmontonraceway.com. There will be some General Admission tickets available for walk-up spectators, however, we anticipate the ticket sales to move very quickly.

Yes, we take Debit, VISA, and Mastercard.

What racing is scheduled for Friday, July 26th? TBA

Is there Parking available right at the

Race Track? Parking is available at the Race

Track at a cost of \$10 per day until spaces sell
out. Parking must be purchased on-site. No "in"
and "out" parking privileges can be
accommodated. On Saturday, July 27th a FREE
SHUTTLE is available from the Wetaskiwin Rodeo
Grounds (7 kms EAST of the Raceway) - this
Shuttle is available from 12 Noon until 1 hour
after the LUXXUR 300 concludes.

Can Motorcycles park at the Race

Track? Yes, there will be an area specifically for motorcycles to park at no charge.

Is there Handicapped Parking at the

Race Track? Yes for vehicles displaying a recognized "Handicapped" tag.

Is Camping allowed at the Race Track?

Due to limited space, motorhomes and travel trailers cannot be accommodated at EIR. We recommend Camping at the new Westview RV Park located right across the highway from the Reynolds Alberta Museum – www.westviewrvpark.com.

You are welcome to use the shuttle from the Wetaskiwin Rodeo Grounds (Saturday Night only) & parking for the event is free there. However if you are parking overnight on Friday and/or Saturday at the Rodeo Grounds, the cost is \$20 per night (no services provided). Please contact Loretta at speedway@syban.net to make arrangements to park overnight at the Rodeo Grounds.

Is there an ATM Machine on the

Grounds? No there is no ATM Machine available however cash advances are available from the Cashier at a cost of 5% per transaction.

Where can Pit Crew Park? We will provide

NPS CREW with 2 complimentary parking passes in the Pit Parking area for Saturday & EIR SATURDAY RACE TEAMS with 1 complimentary parking pass (in addition to each Racer's Hauler) in the Pit Parking area. All other parking will have to be purchased in the Spectator Parking or you may park at the Rodeo Grounds on Saturday and use the Free Shuttle.

What can I bring into the Spectator

Seating area? You are welcome to bring a blanket and/or pillow. No large stadium seats allowed. Cameras are allowed.

What am I not allowed to bring into the

Pace track? There is no outside food allowed at the race track and no outside liquor allowed. Only working dogs are allowed on the premises and must be visibly identified and licensed. No other pets are allowed. No coolers are allowed into the spectator area.

Will there be Food and Gift Vendors at the Race Track? Yes, we are a fully licensed

facility and we will have concessions available for your convenience.

What happens if there is inclement
